Formally

The use of American Sign Language makes this song extra special. Make the sign for love over and over to the beat while swaying and then start singing. This may be done in a round.



LOVE, love, love, love

Cross hands on chest.



PEOPLE

Make a forward cycling motion with hands in the "P" position.

YOUR

Move open palm forward from chest.



CALL.

Touch the hand lightly and pull away.



LOVE

your

Cross hands on chest.



NEIGH

-

Keeping thumbs up, touch fingers together then move straight down with palms facing each other.



BOR

as



YOURSELF,

Move fist with thumb up forward from chest.



for GOD

Gesture up "to Heaven" with hand and bring down in front of forehead to the chest.



LOVES

Cross hands on chest.



US all.

Move hand in the "U" position from one shoulder to the other.
